### **Catechism**

**C: Fathers, do not provoke your children to anger, but bring them up in the discipline and instruction of the Lord.**

P: To children, Luther quoted: **C: Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. “Honor your father and mother” (this is the first commandment with a promise), “that it may go well with you and that you may live long in the land.”**

### **Confession and Absolution**

P: Father in heaven, You have called us to “bring children up in the discipline and instruction of the Lord,” a task that we have not always fulfilled as parents and as a congregation. You have called us to honor our father and mother, yet we have not always showed our parents and other authorities love and respect. In these and other ways, we have sinned in thought,

word, and deed, and we cannot free ourselves from our sinful condition. Together as Your people, we take refuge in Your infinite mercy, seeking Your grace for the sake of Christ, and saying: God, be merciful to me, a sinner.

**C: Almighty God, have mercy upon us, forgive us our sins, and lead us to everlasting life. Amen.**

P: Upon this, your confession, I, by virtue of my office, as a called and ordained servant of the Word, announce the grace of God to all of you, and in the stead and by the command of my Lord Jesus Christ, I forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. **C: Amen.**
